No-Till Tip

Crop residues can build up in reduced tillage programs, and these need to be kept in a constant decay cycle. The decaying residues not only help in keeping weed pressure down, but also continually supply nutrients to the growing crop and keep N from being lost.

We recommend that you add SB5500 and 3– Growth Boost (conventional)/Organic 3r – Growth Boost (organic) to post-emergence herbicide applications to promote residue breakdown and protect N from being lost to leaching/volatilization while increasing soil micronutrient availability.

Protect Beans from Yellow Flash

Remember that post-emergence herbicide applications with glyphosate for Roundup Ready or Liberty soybeans may cause micronutrients like manganese to be chelated and flushed out, so the plant suffers deficiencies. It will cost you yield. We recommend that you foliar apply a post-emergence program including **5 - MicroNutrient Boost** and **Growth Supplement 30** with herbicide applications to improve herbicide effectiveness and stimulate growth.
