# Time to Reflect and Give Thanks

It's the time of the year when we give thanks for another year, and a certain bird receives a presidential pardon. A little Thanksgiving trivia:

- Our American Thanksgiving had a long road to becoming an official federal holiday:
  - It was first celebrated by the Pilgrims in 1621.
  - In 1789 President George Washington called for a day of thanksgiving to thank the almighty for giving citizens "an opportunity peaceably to establish a form of government for their safety and happiness."
  - Thanksgiving then became a national holiday in 1863 when Abraham Lincoln asked citizens to "to set apart and observe the last Thursday of November next as a day of thanksgiving and praise." This followed a 17-year campaign of letters to the White House credited to Sarah Josephina Hale, the same lady who wrote "Mary Had a Little Lamb."
  - It then took until 1941 for Congress to finally designate the fourth Thursday in November as Thanksgiving Day, creating a new federal holiday.
- Many of us have seen a Canadian "Thanksgiving Day" listed on calendars. But, that is a completely different holiday. Thanksgiving Day in Canada is celebrated on the second Monday in October, and commemorates the recovery of the prince of Wales (later King Edward VII) from a serious illness. It was first observed on April 15, 1872.
- Astronauts Neil Armstrong and Edwin Aldrin ate roast turkey in foil packets for their first meal on the Moon. That makes over the river and through the woods look tame!
